



Thank you for taking the time to enquiry about fulfilling your African dream. This document will help you, and us, understand the type of trip you wish to undertake and any variables that need to be taken into consideration.

There are **FIVE** questions, and each question needs to be answered in order for us to provide any assistance in planning your amazing African trip.

### **Q1: LOCATION AND MUST SEES:**

The seed of travelling to Africa has normally been planted through seeing something on television, reading an article in a magazine, stories from family and friends or through online research. Whatever the trigger(s) was you'll probably have an idea of where you want to travel in Africa and some of the things you want to see. List the countries you want to visit and any of the 'must see' things you want incorporate. Maybe it is the Wildebeest Migration in East Africa or standing at the edge of Victoria Falls or being on safari seeing wild African animals.

### **Q2: HOW LONG?**

How long (in days) do you plan to be away for? This question helps in the planning of the style of transport (air verses road etc) and the length of time that could be spend at each location.

### **Q3: WHAT TIME OF YEAR?**

You may be only able to get away at a certain time of year, or you could be quite flexible, but having an idea of when you can travel will also help shape your itinerary. Some events may only occur at specific times of the year (eg: Victoria Falls flow in May, June or July is extensive compared to the trickle in October or November) so ensuring we can get your 'must sees' in, there may have to be some rearranging. Also the order of the itinerary may be altered to take advantage of seasonal discounts, better visiting times etc.

### **Q4: WHOSE TRAVELLING?**

An African trip is suitable for everyone and we can create the perfect itinerary to suit. The makeup of the travelling party can, and will influence lodge, activity and location decisions. You may be travelling on your own but want to be with a group or you may be travelling as part of a multi generational family group. Due to the wild nature of many parts of Africa, age restrictions on children attending lodges or partaking in various

game activities may be restricted. Also some country have entry requirements for those travelling with children under the age of 18 years.


Also, the rooming configuration of the travelling party is important. Some couples like separate beds, some families like to be in one room or to have interconnecting rooms etc so in order to plan correctly we need to know. On group tours the price is normally twin share meaning if you are travelling on your own you'll likely be sharing with someone of the same gender unless you take out a single supplement.

### Q5: HOW MUCH?

The big question! In order for us to create the perfect African holiday we need to know a rough budget of what you think the trip will cost. It doesn't mean we are going to spend that but we need to know what you realistically have in mind so we can choose appropriate style of accommodation, duration at places, mode of transport etc. The four preceding questions will also influence how far your budget will go. In most cases the following diagram is true, where you can have **TWO** of the three:



So if you want to be away for a long duration (21 days or more AND to have it inexpensive) the quality will be less in the sense you are likely to camping doing an overland safari. (Overland safaris are fantastic and really stretch your money!). Or... You may want a 5 star game lodge (high quality) that is comparatively inexpensive, the length of time away is likely to be short.
